



WHAT IS THE SFSP?

The Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) ensures kids have access to nutritious meals when they're out of school. The program is funded by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and administered by the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE).

ALL CHILDREN UNDER 18 are eligible to receive meals- no documentation is required!

HOW TO GET INVOLVED:

BECOME A SPONSOR

Sponsors are responsible for managing SFSP sites. Sponsors must follow regulations and be fiscally and administratively capable of managing the program.

Responsibilities

- Attend SFSP trainings
- Create menus
- Prepare or contract the meals
- Deliver meals to sites
- Train and monitor sites
- Track meal counts
- Submit counts for reimbursement

Who can be a Sponsor?

- Public or private nonprofit schools
- Government agencies
- Private nonprofit organizations
- Public or private nonprofit camps, universities, and colleges

BE A VOLUNTEER

Volunteer with a site or sponsor to help serve meals or lead activities.

BECOME A SITE

SFSP sites are the physical locations where meals are served.

Responsibilities

- Serving and counting meals
- Supervising the kids
- Providing activities

Types of Sites:

- Open: any child can receive a meal
- Closed: only children enrolled in the site's summer program can receive the meal

BE A VENDOR

Organizations with kitchens and food service staff can be an SFSP vendor. Vendors sell prepared meals under an agreement or a contract with an approved SFSP sponsor.
